- To receive a presentation on the NEHTA Strategic Plan.
- To receive an update on the UHI and NASH Programs.
- Understand the development of patient journey models.
- Get an update on the NEHTA Discharge Summary Program.

Summary of Actions:

- Agreed the group be updated on the UHI Program at next meeting.

- Agreed that a demonstration of the Reference Platform to be scheduled for the next meeting.
- NEHTA to compile a set of specific scenarios for the CCRG to review (scenarios built on the UHI and NSI components from the perspective of healthcare organisations and the interactions expected).
- CCRG members to send NEHTA existing customer pathways so they can build the documentation to inform the work around customer requirements.
- NEHTA to distribute the brief on reusability of content developed for specific packages for the CCRG to review.
- Implementation strategy for eReferrals and eDischarge Summaries to be discussed at the next meeting.
- NEHTA to report back to the CCRG on ideas for 'Stakeholder consultation and requirements gathering around opportunity areas such as consumer and provider portals, health profile summaries and shared care planning'.
- Agreed the group get an update from the Medications and Diagnostics Reference Groups at the next meeting.

Summary of Outcomes:

- Agreed that the NEHTA Discharge Summary to continue to focus on undertaking alignment studies with potential implementation partners to process pre Implementation Planning activities.
