PCEHR to enhance healthcare for mothers and newborns

Project

Will implement a PCEHR for maternity patients and newborn babies. The project involves three GP Divisions (South East Alliance, Brisbane South and the South East Primary HealthCare network).

The project will partner with private specialists, private and public hospitals and GP's. The project provides a specific focus on Mothers and New Born babies, which is one of the priority target cohorts. It also actively involves specialist obstetricians in the project, thus involving an important Provider cohort alongside the core GP community.

Demographics

Brisbane wide coverage; maternity patients and newborn babies.
Population reach of nearly 10,000 mothers.

Approach

The project will implement consumer and provider portals and will link to the Wave 1 PCEHR repository to source relevant consumer information from their primary care clinicians. This also facilitates further re-use of the Wave 1 PCEHR repository.
