Project

This project will establish a Wave 2 PCEHR community based around St Vincent's & Mater Health Sydney, in conjunction with partnering Divisions of General Practice, participating specialists and leading software vendors including Smart Health, Precedence, HCN and Best Practice.

The project will improve clinical communication across the project's footprint through the delivery of key PCEHR components including GP health summaries, GP referrals and interoperability between two major Australian shared electronic health record solutions, Smart Health Solutions and Precedence Healthcare.

Approach

By building on lessons learnt from previous electronic health record trials (such as HealthConnect) will ensure that the project's PCEHR is sustainable. Accordingly, the PCEHR will support all clients attending the St Vincent's campus from participating GP's. This approach will ensure the use of the PCEHR can become a mainstream component of the clinical workflow as opposed to doing something different for a small section of the population. This approach also ensures coverage of all national priority populations including complex and chronic disease, older Australians, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, mothers and babies and the homeless.
