What is the PCEHR System?



- The PCEHR System is a secure system which enables individuals to store and share clinical documents that are important to their ongoing care
- Participation is voluntary and individuals will have a range of controls over the record
- The PCEHR System will be underpinned by
 - Rigorous governance and oversight to maintain privacy
 - National standards and core national infrastructure
- The PCEHR systems complements (not replaces) existing records and clinical communications

Progress to Date



- What are we working on now:
 - Developing additional detailed requirements and specifications
 - Locking in standards development plan with the standards community
- Next Steps:
 - More consultation
 - Public consultation on legal issues in preparation for drafting legislation
 - Build the system
 - Develop change and adoption program

Lead Sites



- Purpose
- Deploy and test national eHealth infrastructure and standards
- Demonstrate tangible outcomes and benefits
- Build stakeholder support and momentum
- Provide a meaningful foundation for further enhancement and roll-out of the national PCEHR system
