Summary of Actions:

- Following a HI Service update, agreed that an Implementation Collateral Project (ICP) tiger team to be held to discuss merging data and/or what information is held.
- Agreed that Medicare Australia test cases be coordinated with NEHTA Compliance, Conformance and Accreditation (CCA) test cases.
- HI implementation and adoption currently IHI focused in Jurisdictions. NEHTA to consider how clearer communication about what Jurisdictions are doing can be managed.

Summary of Outcomes:

- For issues such as access, identity and authentication in relation to PCEHR, IAARG will be the Reference Group to discuss these as they already form part of the IAARG's Terms of Reference. The Co-Chairs will nominate people to work on PCEHR Tiger Teams.
- The IAARG is to be involved in HI Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) development.
